## **QUESTIONS & DISCUSSION**

In 1 Thessalonians 4:1-12, we see a clear difference between living the world's way and living in a way that pleases God. God calls us to live with holiness, grow in our understanding of Him, live with integrity, and, as 1 Thessalonians 4:11–12 says, to live quietly, mind our own business, and work with our hands—so that our lives earn the respect of others and reflect God's goodness.

Q 01 "Which part of living to please God—pursuing holiness, growing in wisdom, living with integrity, or living a quiet and respectful life—stands out to you right now, and why?"

"The greatest failure is succeeding in the wrong things."

Q 02 What is one way you hear the Lord calling you out of the way of the world, and into His will?

1 Thessalonians 4 reminds us that living of purity means turning away from sin and choosing a holy life. Revival starts when we take responsibility for our choices and let God change how we live—especially in our homes and daily habits.

Q 03 "What does it look like for you to go to war with anything that's keeping you from living a life that pleases God?
